

- Make sure to water early in the morning. Note a deeper drink a few times a week is more beneficial this time of year. An application of wettasoil may help if hydrophobic (repels water) Apply mulch to gardens, especially straw or sugar cane mulch to strawberry patches to retail moisture and help repel snails damage as they don't like to crawl over. Give your roses a light summer prune to encourage new growth. We have various secature in store to assist, which you should sterilise with methylated spirits' before use.


-Now is a good time to re-oil outdoor timber furniture with linseed oil to protect and last longer Avail in 11, 2.5 or 5L





ust Keepin' It Cool In January

- Cooling vest uses long-lasting cooling polymer crystals that absorb water to help keep dogs cool and comfortable for hours.
- Zippy Paws Cooling Vest is a high-visibility reflective vest designed for the active dog. The bright blue colour and reflective stripes help keep dogs visible during night-time walks, and in low-light conditions.

*With the warmer weather finally upon us it is crucial to be on the look out for blackberry growth. Thriving in the heat, blackberries can grow two feet on average over night infesting your garden and taking over your pastures.

*Best to start the control of blackberries at the beginning of October and continue to spray all the way through to March.

*Weed-force Renovate is a low dose, low toxicity herbicide which can be used safely around stock. Relatively slow acting compared with other woody weed herbicides but very effective in achieving long term control

*When using renovate remember to always add Holdfast wetting agent/ penetrant as this improves wetting and penetration of plant foliage to result in superior weed control especially of tough, difficult to wet broadleaf and woody weeds like blackberries gorse, and bracken.

*Be sure to avoid spraying on really hot days however, as temperatures nearing and exceed 40°C cause blackberries to shutoff their ability to soak up liquid to retain moisture. Meaning that the renovate won't be as effective as it won't be
